Due to the ever increasing popularity and demand for women's racing in the UK, an exciting addition is the Women's race that follows at midday, offering equal prize money to the Elite race that begins at 13.15. With over £1300 thus far in the prize fund (with it increasing all the time) the races promise to be fast and frantic with some of the best riders from the UK battling it out for the coveted Crit on the Campus trophies.**

**Whether competing or soaking up the atmosphere, Crit on the Campus should be an enjoyable day out for all on Scotland's most beautiful campus.**

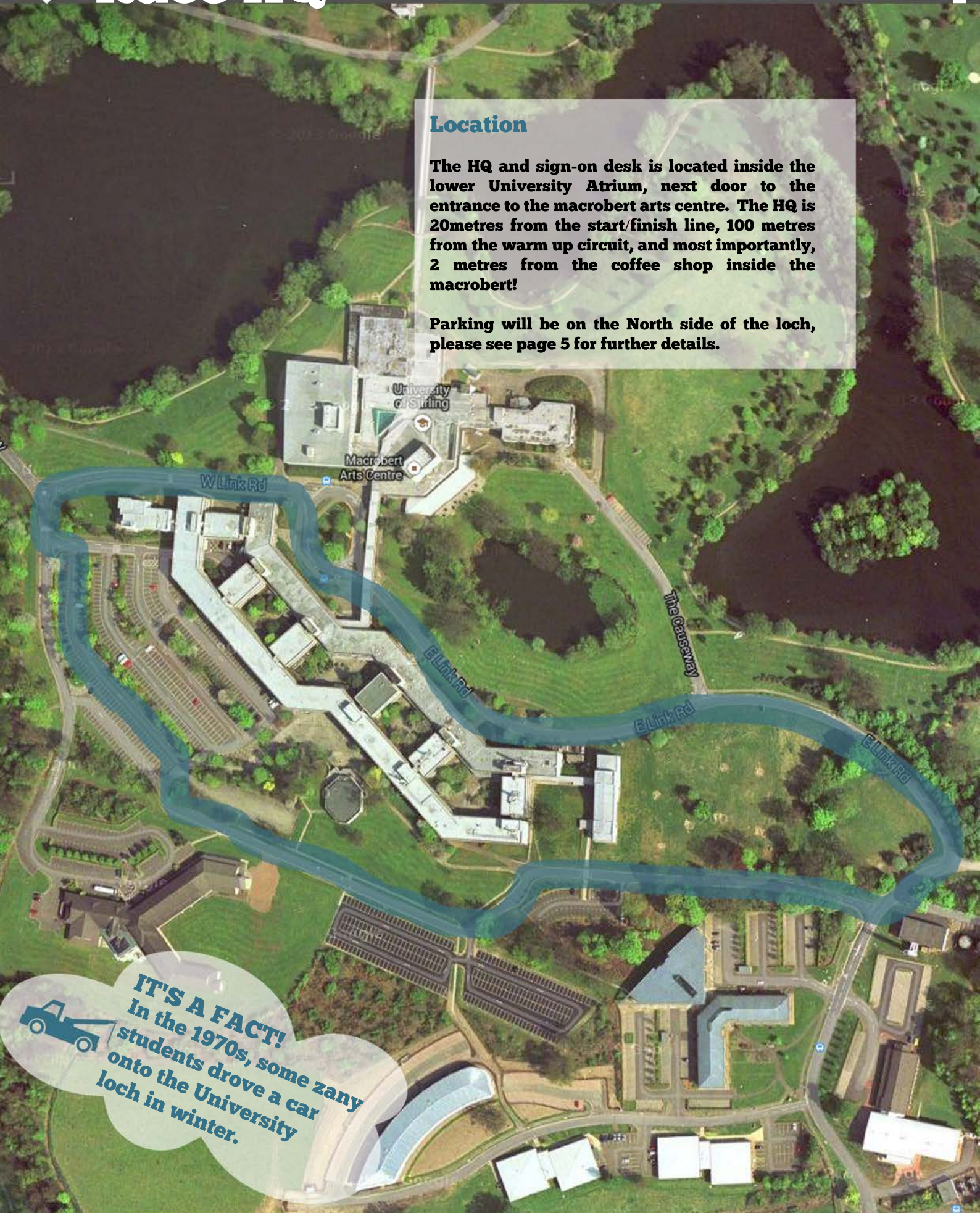




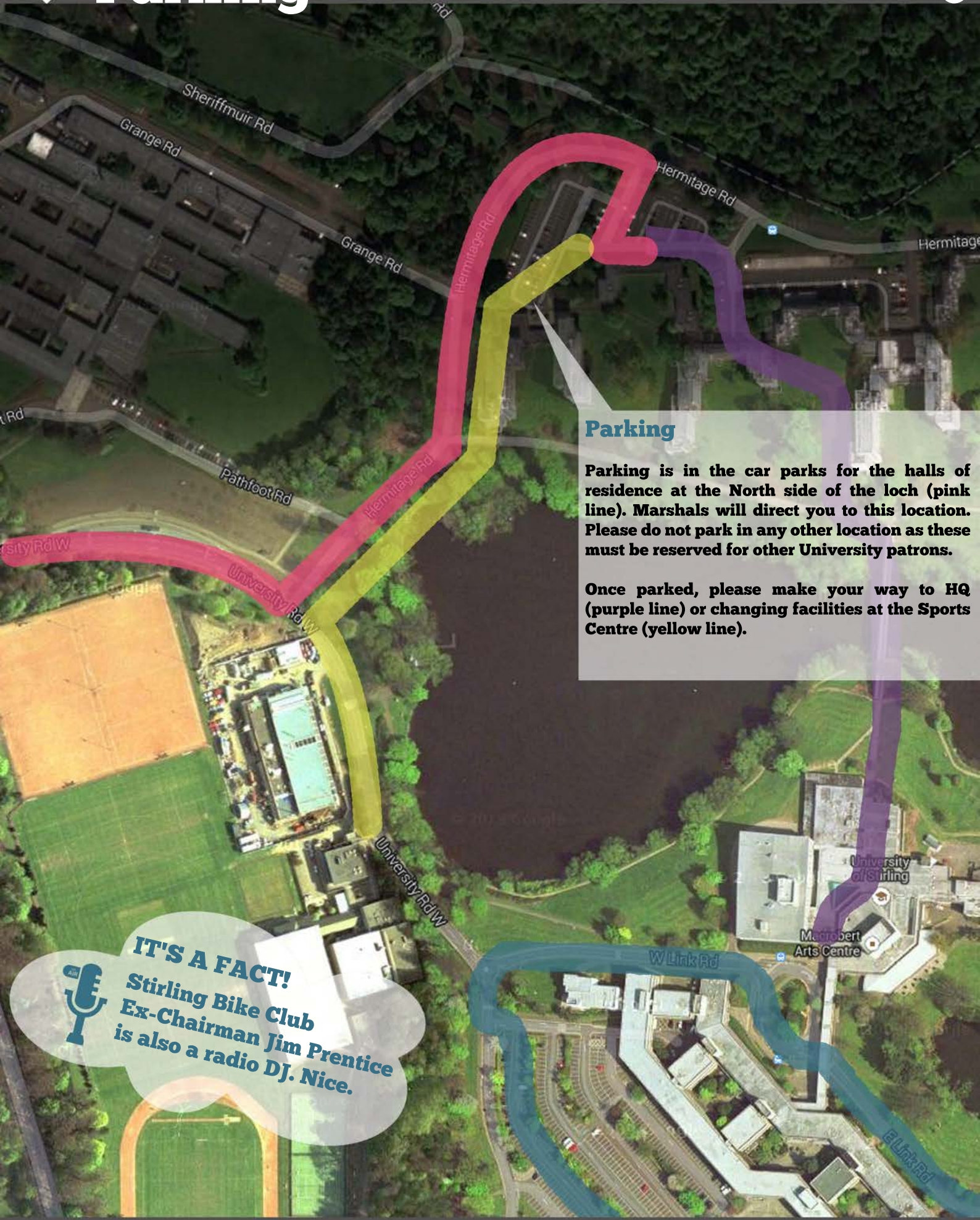
### Location

In the 1970s, some zany students drove a car onto the University loch in winter.

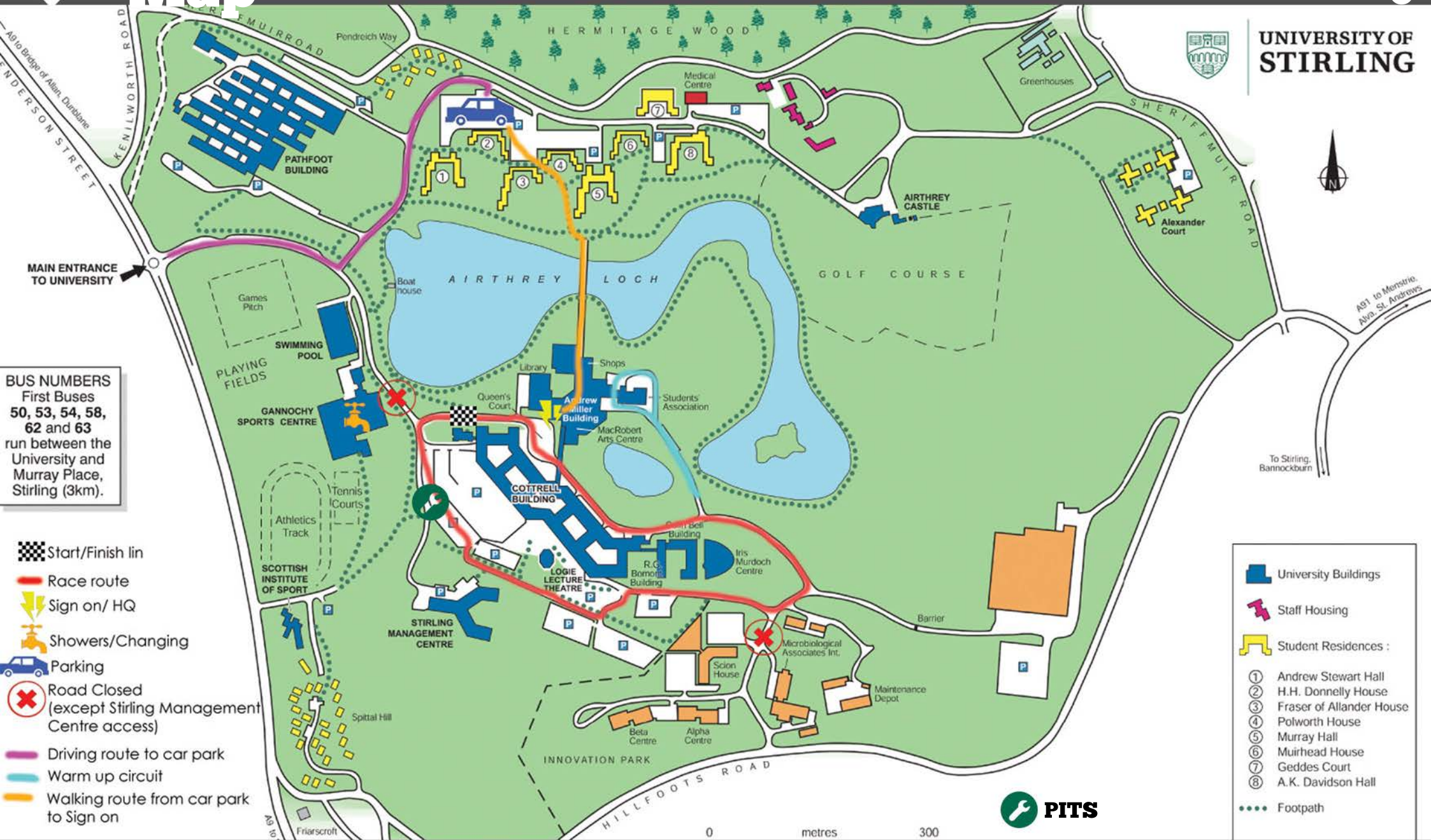


### Parking

If you are racing the 4th cat, womens or youth races without a license, you are going to need a day license. Prices vary depending on if you are a British Cycling member:

Senior (No membership): £10

we will know if you have a license or not, if you don't have one, please bring the correct amount and pay at registration.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The E/1/2/3 Race is a National race and therefore day licenses cannot be purchased on the day. No license=no racy=sadface.

## Technical Gubbins (the smallprint)

### The Pits are marked on the map

You can have 1 lap out for a mechanical/crash/puncture and can go back into the race. No laps out with 5 laps to go.

### Feeding

Feeding (food and drink handouts) only allowed from the Pits. But, come on, all races are under an hour!!

### Lapped Riders

If you get lapped you can stay in the race until 5 laps to go (excluding Youths), but DO NOT interfere with the leaders or collude with teammates. You will get fined.

### Youths

Lapped riders will not be pulled out due to combination of categories in some races.

### All other races

Lapped riders will be pulled from the race with 5 laps to go to avoid interfering with the leaders. A whistle will sound to any lapped riders to signify that lap will be your final. After this lap, please make your way to the pit area (marked on the map). Should a group of leaders catch/lap the main field, the main field will finish with 5 laps to go leaving the leaders to contest the finish

## Other Rider notes

**Youth and Juniors:** Your bikes will be checked to ensure you are riding on the restricted gears for your category. Please come nice and early. There's a whole heap of bikes to check!

**Race service:** There is no service, only the aforementioned Pit lane. Stirling Bike Club/University of Stirling are not responsible for any wheels or equipment left unattended.

**Briefing:** There will be rider briefings before each race. Please listen carefully as the circuit does have some hazards!
